OVERVIEW

This fully online program provides school teachers who are already certified in Early Childhood Education (Birth–Grade 2), Childhood Education (Grades 1–6), or Special Education with a 15-credit program leading to the New York State Extension in Bilingual Education. The Extension in Bilingual Education qualifies the candidate to work as a teacher in bilingual classrooms and programs in New York State schools, including dual language and transitional bilingual education programs. This program can be completed in one year.

WHO THIS PROGRAM IS FOR

The program is for certified bilingual teachers who are looking to obtain the required NYS authorization to teach in bilingual education programs.
