PROGRAM DESCRIPTION The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) in Early Childhood Education (Birth-Grade 2) serves those who wish to work in early childhood educational settings, including infant and toddler programs, preschools, and pre-kindergarten through grade 2 classrooms. This 36 credit program comprises coursework, field experiences, and a student teaching semester that focus on developmentally appropriate content and pedagogical strategies that enhance young children's academic and social success. Full-time students complete the program in three semesters. Part-time options are available.

MAT 1-6 Childhood

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) in Childhood Education (Grades 1-6) prepares future teachers to earn NYS certification in the elementary school teaching profession. This 36 credit program stresses reflective teaching and the proactive role of the teacher in enhancing educational quality. The program exposes students incrementally to include the study of educational foundations, pedagogy, curriculum and standards, and assessment, with principles of field practice integrated into the coursework at each level. Full-time students complete the program in three semesters. Part-time options are available.
