<u>LEAP to Teacher (LTT)</u> is a collaborative program between the <u>CUNY School of Labor and Urban Studies</u> (<u>SLU</u>) and several CUNY colleges including Queens College. The LTT program's mission is to empower participants to become more effective in their schools and more impactful in their communities. LTT provides a set of **free specialized support services to all school and daycare workers** pursuing undergraduate, graduate degrees or certificates at Queens College and partnering CUNY colleges, advancing their careers in teaching or other fields.

Eligibility

To be part of the LTT program at Queens College and receive free services, you must be:

- o Currently working in a school or daycare setting.
- Attending or planning to apply to an undergraduate or graduate program at Queens College

LTT Students Pursuing New York State Teacher Certification at Queens College will receive:

- 1. <u>SLU LEAP to Teacher Scholarship</u>: This <u>scholarship</u> was created to assist Paraprofessionals/Teaching Assistants employed with the NYC Public Schools. Applicants must be admitted and enrolled as a Queens College graduate student in a NYC teacher shortage area including Special Education, TESOL, Math and Science. The LTT scholarship is offered only once a year and will be announced two months earlier than its deadline. Please note the teacher shortage areas are subject to change based on the New York City Department of Education needs. - **2. NY State Teacher Certification Exam Prep Workshops:** The LTT program will host free virtual preparatory workshops for the Educating All Students Test (EAS) and the Multi-subject Content Specialty Test (CST) and CST- Students with Disabilities. These workshops provide an opportunity to get support to successfully pass the certification exam. LTT students get emails for workshop registration throughout the semester.
