- At least a $\mathbf{3 . 0}$ cumulative grade point average in mathematics and secondary education courses;
- New York State Initial Certificate in Mathematics, Grades (7-12);
- Bilingual language proficiency in a language in which the applicant is seeking the extension.


## Program Course Requirements:

The program consists of 30 credits: 15 credits in Mathematics Education and 15 credits in Bilingual Education. In bilingual education courses, a total of 50 hours of fieldwork experience is required.
