Doctor of Humane Letters, *Honoris Causa*



A CAREER LIBRARIAN WITH A SYMPATHETIC EYE ON THE YOUTH OF TODAY AND TOMORROW,

Carole A. Barham has offered a helping hand up to young people throughout the metropolitan area.

As a student, Mrs. Barham embarked on her life's path with a bachelor's degree in elementary and early childhood education from Queens College, then completed a master's in library science from Rutgers University. She committed to public education, serving as head of school libraries in East Brunswick, New Jersey, and as head librarian in Columbia High School in South Orange/Maplewood, New Jersey.

Mrs. Barham has consistently concerned herself with the public good. In the 1990s, she was a volunteer for the National Women's Political Caucus in New York. In retirement, she has persevered in helping young people in her former school district. She contributes to such efforts as Beyond the Bell, an after-school enrichment program for grade schoolers, and the Parenting Center, which provides elementary-school families with parenting workshops,

support groups, a speaker series, a toy drive, a library, and other services. At the same time, she continues to support library programs and students at Rutgers University. Now living in Florida, she also supports local philanthropic work.

In addition, she has continued her support of Queens College. In furtherance of her dedication to public education, as well as diversity, she and her husband founded the Carole A. and Norman Barham Family Foundation. Its goals center on charitable giving for education, recreation, family and youth services, and health and social services. Through their foundation, they have been unstinting toward Queens College. They created scholarship funds for students in Queens College's elementary and early education program, QC's bachelor in business administration program, and high-achieving, financially needy students living in the Summit Apartments. Most recently, they provided financial support for internships. In 2010, Queens College named the fourth-floor study lounge in the Summit Apartments the Carole A. and Norman Barham Lounge.

They also established the Carole and Norman Barham Library Endowment in support of the Queens College Library—a gift that goes to the heart of QC's educational mission and that speaks to their own professional knowledge and concerns. In appreciation for their longstanding generosity, Queens College dedicated the Carole A. and Norman Barham Rotunda in the Benjamin Rosenthal Library in 2008.

In her work, Mrs. Barham has held the meaning of community close. She exemplifies the Queens College motto: *Discimus ut serviamus* (We learn so that we may serve). In recognition of her deeply held values, her achievements as an educator and philanthropist, and her service to public education, Queens College is proud to confer upon Carole A. Barham the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

Doctor of Humane Letters, *Honoris Causa*



A FINANCIAL EXECUTIVE, PHILANTHROPIST, AND RESPECTED CIVIC LEADER,

Norman Barham has lent his experience and talents to the cause of public education. His good work is known and esteemed by the many institutions and students he has helped over the years.

Mr. Barham has enjoyed a sterling career in finance. After earning his BA from Queens College, he went on to hold numerous executive positions. Those included senior management roles in various parts of Johnson & Higgins—including as president, chief technical officer, and head of Global Property Insurance. After the merger of Johnson & Higgins with Marsh & McLennan Companies, he served as vice chairman and president of global operations at Marsh, Inc., the largest diversified insurance brokerage and risk-management service company in the world. His professional expertise has been highly valued. Besides serving on many boards, he is a past president of the Insurance Brokers' Association of New York.

Mr. Barham is also a leader in organizations promoting the public good. He serves on the advisory council of New York City Outward Bound Schools, which, in partnership with the New York City Department of Education, brings character and leadership

development programming to students as well as programs that assist them in their college applications and careers. In addition, he is a former member of the executive committee of the Huntington's Disease Society of America; in 1997 he was awarded its Marjorie Guthrie Leadership Award. Now living in Florida, he supports local philanthropic causes as well.

In furtherance of his dedication to public education, as well as diversity, he and his wife founded the Carole A. and Norman Barham Family Foundation, which allocates charitable giving for education, recreation, family and youth services, and health and social services. Their foundation has been generous toward Queens College students. It created scholarship funds for students in Queens College's elementary and early education program; QC's bachelor in business administration program; high-achieving, financially needy students living in the Summit Apartments; and, most recently, internships. In 2010, Queens College named the fourth-floor study lounge in the Summit Apartments the Carole A. and Norman Barham Lounge.

They also established the Carole A. and Norman Barham Library Endowment in support of the Queens College Library—a gift that supports the core of a liberal arts education. In appreciation for their longstanding generosity, Queens College dedicated the Carole A. and Norman Barham Rotunda in the Benjamin Rosenthal Library in 2008.

Mr. Barham has prospered in the world while remaining true to this community. An alumni leader, Mr. Barham was a Gala honoree in 2000. He served on the Queens College Foundation's board of trustees from 1999 to 2014, and as its chair from 2004 to 2006. Queens College believes that he exemplifies its motto: *Discimus ut serviamus* (We learn so that we may serve).

In recognition of his deeply held values, his achievements as a businessman, philanthropist, and civic leader, and his service to public education, Queens College is proud to confer upon Norman Barham the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

Julia Chaney-Moss

Queens College President's Medal



AN ELOQUENT VOICE FOR JUSTICE, Reverend Julia Chaney-Moss has been an ambassador of African American history and struggle. Her life's work honors the legacy of her brother James Earl Chaney, the civil rights martyr who was murdered as a young man and when she herself was only seventeen.

A native of Meridian, Mississippi, on the frontlines of the civil rights movement, Rev. Chaney-Moss is the daughter of the late Ben Chaney, Sr., a plasterer, and Fannie Lee Chaney, a baker. James, or J.E., was the eldest son in a family of five children. She remembers him as a playful person who loved practical jokes, but who was expelled from high school for recruiting students to join the NAACP. In talking with his mother, his sister recalled for GulfLive.com, "his burning question ... was: Why do we have to live this way? We, as a people." He joined the first Freedom Rides, then was a local volunteer for CORE. His introduction of CORE workers to church leaders paved the way for Michael Schwerner to receive permission to hold a Freedom School at Mount Zion Methodist Church—permission that was met by the firebombing of the church. J.E. Chaney knew all along that he risked retribution, including that he could be killed at any time, and she remembers he instructed his family whom to call if he disappeared.

As Freedom Summer began in 1964, her brother was murdered—along with Michael Schwerner and Andrew Goodman—by the Ku Klux Klan. They were killed for joining the historic effort to register African American voters in segregated Mississippi. International outrage over the murders contributed to passage of the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

As the sister of James Chaney, Rev. Chaney Moss faced not only the lasting trauma of her brother's death, but ongoing threats of violence from white supremacists. Her mother, who was outspoken on race, was fired for her son's civil rights work and sued five restaurants for discrimination, but was unable to find work locally anymore. She and her youngest child moved to New York City after many hate crimes were committed against them. Rev. Chaney-Moss, who had married and graduated from nursing school, remained in Meridian another five years, then also moved to New York for the safety of her two young daughters.

A seeker, Rev. Chaney-Moss embarked on a life of faith and service, resolving not to be harmed spiritually by her brother's killers. "I've always disliked the word hate. I want no part of the damage it can do. I want to stay focused on the power of love, the power of humanity," she wrote in *Plough Quarterly*. She earned certificates at New York University and began a forty-year career at New York Foundling, a social-service agency that empowers children and families to attain their full potential. She also became an interfaith minister and, during International Women's Month from 1998 to 2009, led A Grand Gathering of Sisters—a program she founded for women's spiritual healing and empowerment. A sought-after motivational speaker, she delivered the keynote speech for Church Women United at an event in the Chapel at the United Nations held in honor of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Her courage in facing fear with love was featured in the documentary *Women of the Struggle: Facing Fear in the Civil Rights Era*.

A tireless leader, Rev. Chaney-Moss often speaks out in the media and at public events. Highlights include the twenty-fifth anniversary of the murders in 1989, when she was part of a civil rights caravan through Mississippi; as she told the Associated Press, she hoped it would "educate the youth and re-educate those older of us who maybe have become complacent in our lives." In 2014, marking the 50th anniversary of Freedom Summer, she joined the Children's Defense Fund in the painful work of leading about 400 young people in retracing the final journey of her brother, Andrew Goodman, and Michael Schwerner. Closer to her present-day home, she volunteered at the Underground Railroad Museum of Burlington County, New Jersey.

In appreciation for her services to humanity, her vigilance in the ongoing struggle for democracy and human rights, her selfless efforts in educating future leaders, and her life's work of honoring her brother's sacrifice, we are proud to present Rev. Julia Chaney-Moss with the Queens College President's Medal, our highest administrative honor.

David Goodman

Queens College President's Medal



A LEADER IN DEFENDING AND DEEPENING DEMOCRACY, David Goodman has devoted his life to expanding and protecting the right to vote, educating voters, and training new generations of leaders. In that life's work, he has honored the legacy of his brother and civil rights martyr Andrew Goodman.

A native New Yorker, Mr. Goodman grew up in a middle-class family who believed in the foundational concept that "all people are created equal." His parents Robert, a civil engineer, and Carolyn, a clinical psychologist who taught at Albert Einstein College of Medicine, were deeply concerned with social justice. His mother's activism began during the Great Depression and continued despite the chill of the McCarthy era. David and his older brothers Andrew and Jonathan were well educated. Andrew was a student at Queens College when he answered the call for civil-rights volunteers.

During Freedom Summer in 1964, Mr. Goodman's life was forever changed by his older brother's murder by the Ku Klux Klan. Along with Michael Schwerner and James Chaney, Andy was killed for joining the effort to register African American voters in segregated Mississippi. Public outrage over the murders contributed to passage of the Voting Rights Act of 1965. The shocking violence and deep sense of loss led the family to start the Andrew Goodman Foundation in 1966 for the purpose of supporting social causes in his memory; Carolyn and Robert Goodman used that platform to fight for civil and voting rights, women's rights, and children's rights.

As one of the key leaders of the Andrew Goodman Foundation, Mr. Goodman has honored that legacy. Upon the death of his mother in 2007, and together with his wife Sylvia Golbin-Goodman, he transformed the private foundation into a public charity.

Innovative administrators, the Goodmans have promoted several initiatives. In 2014, marking the 50th anniversary of Freedom Summer, the Foundation launched the Andrew Goodman Vote Everywhere program with the mission of "making young voices and votes a powerful force in democracy." It focuses on student voter participation and registration, getting out the vote, and tackling the problem of voter suppression of students in particular. That program partners with colleges (including Queens College), universities, and young people to develop a network of young leaders equipped to build voters' civic participation: ordinary people described as a "hero citizenry." They work on sixty-nine campuses—eighteen of them at historically black colleges and universities—in twenty-six states and Washington, D.C., creating student Andrew Goodman Ambassadors who host events and register voters around the nation. The Goodmans' leadership also includes creating the Andrew Goodman National Civic Leadership Training Summit as well as the Andrew Goodman Puffin Democracy Fellowship, which supports post-graduates undertaking high-impact projects that advance political and social equity among young people. The recent creation of the Sylvia and David Goodman Legacy Fund will ensure that the Foundation's work continues into the future.

An effective voice for civil society, Mr. Goodman serves many non-profit organizations. With a BS in civil engineering from Antioch College and MBA from Stanford University, he is the former founding CEO of United American Energy Corp., an electric-power company that operated in eight states. He is a member of the U.S. Green Building Council, the American Solar Energy Society, and the global leadership council of the Natural Resources Defense Council. He serves on the advisory boards of the Natural History Museum of the Adirondacks and the Ruby Bridges Foundation, and he is a trustee emeritus of Antioch College.

In appreciation for his services to humanity, his principled defense of democracy and racial justice, his dedication to empowering future generations of leaders, and his profound work of honoring his brother's sacrifice, we are proud to present David Goodman with the Queens College President's Medal, our highest administrative honor.

Stephen A. Schwerner

Queens College President's Medal



A LIFELONG VOICE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE,

Stephen A. Schwerner has been a psychologist, teacher, administrator, and radio host. As the brother of murdered civil rights organizer Michael Schwerner, he also has preserved and honored his brother's legacy of conviction and struggle.

A native of the Bronx, Mr. Schwerner was the son of first-generation Americans. He grew up steeped in progressive culture. His mother Anne Seigel Schwerner (MS '58), who held a BA in biology from Hunter College and a master's in education from Queens College, was a teacher and union activist. His father Nathan, a graduate of City College and Columbia University, was a lawyer and businessman who became the national secretary of the National Emergency Civil Liberties Committee. Their children followed in their footsteps.

An early activist, in the 1950s Steve Schwerner attended Antioch College, which had a liberal, interracial history dating from the mid-nineteenth century. He earned a BA in secondary education and, while a student, was active in Antioch's NAACP chapter, then headed by future Congresswoman Eleanor Holmes Norton (D-DC). Returning to the city for an EdD in counseling psychology at New York University, in the 1960s he joined Downtown CORE (Congress of Racial Equality) as did his wife Nancy, his younger brother Mickey, and Mickey's wife, now Rita Schwerner Bender '64.

A prominent member of the Queens College community, Mr. Schwerner worked on campus from 1963 until 1976. Beginning with an internship, he moved up to become director of counseling. He served on the steering committee of the new academic senate, which opened college governance to students, then became its chair. During the Vietnam War, he was the City University of New York's first draft counselor—serving officially in that capacity at Queens College for a conflict he also organized against—and he was faculty advisor to the college's CORE chapter.

In Freedom Summer of 1964, Mickey Schwerner—along with Andrew Goodman and James Chaney—was murdered by the Ku Klux Klan for his work with CORE in Mississippi, which involved training civil-rights volunteers, registering African American voters, and organizing freedom schools. "Everybody I knew and people that I didn't know rallied around me at Queens College," Steve Schwerner recalled. National outcry over the murders helped achieve congressional passage of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and the family responded to their loss with even greater activism, but as he told the Associated Press, "I don't think anybody in our family has ever got over it."

An accomplished educator, Mr. Schwerner returned to Antioch in 1976 as dean of students. He held that position for fifteen years, then taught for another thirteen, including his signature courses on the civil rights movement and on the history of jazz. In his last years there, he was active in the Antioch College Continuation Corporation, an alumni organization that mobilized successfully to save the economically struggling institution.

Always present for the community, Mr. Schwerner was the volunteer host of jazz radio programs in Yellow Springs, Ohio, over a span of many years. He fought for social justice wherever he lived and worked, even helping to start a food coop. As he told the Brooklyn College Listening Project, "You're not human if you're not working to make people's lives better."

In appreciation for his lifetime of service to humanity, his uncompromising advocacy for racial justice, his outstanding contributions to higher education, and his years of work in honoring his brother's sacrifice, we are proud to present our colleague Stephen Schwerner with the Queens College President's Medal, our highest administrative honor.

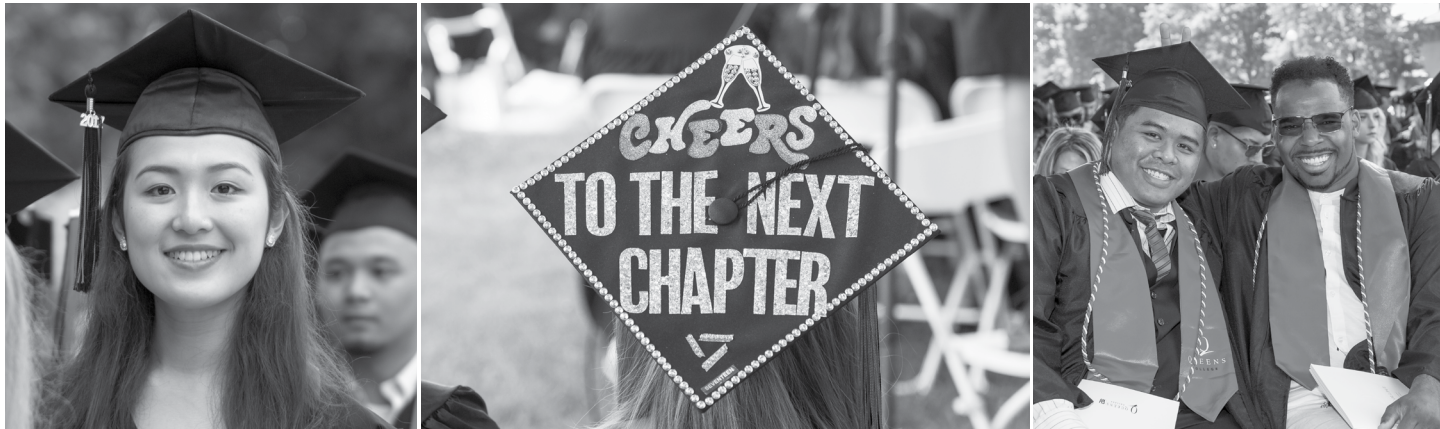

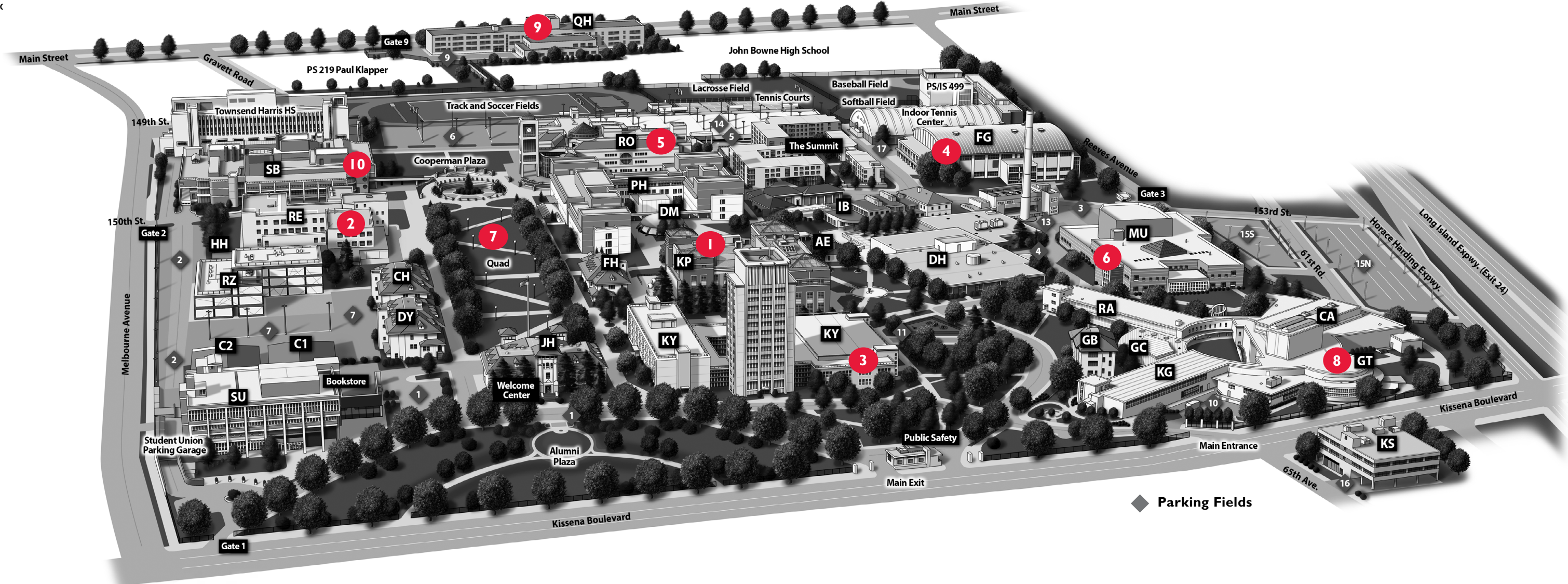

About Commencement

Today’s ceremonies are rooted in centuries-old traditions. Commencement—from the Old French word *commencement*, which means “beginning”—was the name of the ceremony at which university graduates (then called “masters”) were initiated into the teaching profession in medieval Europe. A commencement ceremony acknowledges the success of an institution as well as its students.

The first Queens College commencement ceremony—honoring the 198-member graduating class—took place on Monday, June 16, 1941. Students, their families, and friends had decorated the Quadrangle with flowers brought from their homes. The procession of dignitaries, which included President Paul Klapper, Dean of Faculty Margaret Kiely, Judge Charles Colden, and commencement speaker Mayor Fiorello LaGuardia, was soaked by a sudden downpour.

This is Queens College’s one hundredth commencement. When the college first opened, commencement was held twice a year. Now, although degrees are also awarded in September and February, formal graduation exercises are held in late May or early June. Recipients of degrees awarded during the year are invited to participate in the formal commencement ceremonies.

Marshals are members of the faculty and staff who have volunteered to assist at commencement. They wear academic gowns, carry wooden batons, and perform various organizational assignments, such as assembling and leading the candidates in procession.

The academic procession is a tradition stemming from early universities. Centuries ago, such processions were arranged by the clergy and followed the familiar order of religious processions, with the place of honor at the end. In today’s ceremony, the president, chief marshal, and members of the platform party—including provost, department chairs, board of trustee members and representatives from CUNY, the deans who represent the candidates, college officials, the honorary degree recipients, the commencement speaker, student representatives, and various public dignitaries—will march down the middle aisle, followed by the faculty. Also, four columns of graduates will march in simultaneously, with master’s degree candidates at the head of each column. Banners will identify each division. Special guests for today’s ceremony will be members of the 40th anniversary Class of

1984, 50th anniversary Class of 1974, 60th anniversary Class of 1964, 70th anniversary Class of 1954, 75th anniversary Class of 1949, and the 80th anniversary Class of 1944.

The chief marshal, traditionally a senior faculty member who has provided long and faithful service to the college, leads the platform party and serves as mace bearer. Though now purely ceremonial, the tradition of the mace bearer dates back to medieval England when an official taking office or opening court needed a bodyguard. In those times, the mace was a formidable weapon, held ready to protect the official. The chief marshal carries the Queens College mace, which has historic significance. Made of dark cherry wood, the mace is adorned with red granite and sterling silver and embedded with a bronze medal showing the original college seal; the seal bears the college’s motto, *Discimus ut Serviamus*, Latin for “We learn so that we may serve.” The medal was originally presented to the first registrar of the college, Howard Knag, who donated it for the mace. The chief marshal wears a chain of office that includes sterling silver links inscribed with the names and years of past chief marshals. The chain and current mace were a gift from Professor Emeritus John B. Haney, himself a former chief marshal. President Frank H. Wu will also wear a chain of office listing past presidents of the college and their tenures. Donated by past chief marshals, it was provided thanks to a collaboration between former chief marshal Jared Rifkin and Joseph Brostek ’55, long-time director of commencement.

The gowns worn by the graduates represent a dignified and truly democratic custom. At the moment when the degrees are conferred, all the gowned graduates are made equal. Until well into the nineteenth century, it was customary for many American students to wear gowns while in daily residence at college or at meals. Now, with the exception of some British and European schools, few colleges request that students wear these gowns except at graduation exercises.

Caps, called mortarboards—with a tassel hanging on the right side—are worn by degree candidates. As the college president confers the degrees, the candidates symbolically move the tassels to the left side of their mortarboard. Graduates may wear different color cords to represent honor societies and special programs.

While academic costumes have been used in this country since colonial times, there was no uniformity until the late 1890s. Today, the gowns of most universities are black. The hoods worn by the faculty indicate their degrees. The silk lining of the hood gives the color or colors of the institution granting the degree. Traditionally, the shortest hood is the bachelor’s, the longest and broadest is the doctor’s, and the master’s and specialist’s are midway between (although Queens College bachelor’s degree candidates do not wear hoods, some may wear red satin stoles). The color of the velvet binding or edging designates academic disciplines. Among the more frequently seen colors are:
