- **TAP** (Programa de Asistencia Para la Matricula universitaria): \$1000 a \$5,665
 - Cobertura limite de 4 años (no más de 8 semestres de tiempo completo)
- **PTAP** (Programa de Asistencia Para la Matricula universitaria a Tiempo Parcial): cobertura de 6-11 creditos
- **APTS** (Ayuda Para Estudios de Tiempo Parcial): 3 – 11 creditos

NYS Dream Act (Jose Peralta)

El NYS DREAM Act permite a los estudiantes indocumentados y otros estudiantes elegibles solicitar una o más ayudas del Estado de Nueva York, como TAP y la Beca Excelsior. No es necesario completar FAFSA para acceder a esta ayuda.

Requisitos:

- Asistencia y finalización de la escuela secundaria
- Matricula estatal de SUNY o CUNY
- Ciudadanía o estatus migratorio:
 - o Visa U
 - o Visa T
 - o Estatus de Protección Temporal –TPS
 - o Estudiantes indocumentados, incluidos aquellos con estatus de DACA

Los estudiantes indocumentados (incluidos los solicitantes de asilo) que no residen en Nueva York pueden acogerse a la tasa de matrícula para residentes del Estado de Nueva York si cumplen los siguientes requisitos:

- Asistió a una escuela secundaria aprobada por el NYS durante dos o más años, se graduó y solicitó asistir a una institución de la Universidad de la Ciudad de Nueva York (CUNY) en los cinco años siguientes a la obtención del diploma del NYS.
- Ha asistido a un programa aprobado del Estado de Nueva York para la preparación del examen del diploma de equivalencia de estudios secundarios del Estado de Nueva York (GED), ha obtenido un diploma de equivalencia de estudios secundarios o GED expedido en el Estado de Nueva York y ha solicitado la admisión en una institución de la City University of New York (CUNY) en los cinco años siguientes a la obtención del diploma de equivalencia de estudios secundarios o GED del Estado de Nueva York.
- Los estudiantes que reúnan los requisitos de estudios anteriores y que estén indocumentados (o pendientes de asilo) deben presentar una declaración jurada ante notario en la Universidad de la Ciudad de Nueva York (CUNY) en la que indiquen que han presentado una solicitud para legalizar su situación migratoria o que presentarán dicha solicitud en cuanto reúnan los requisitos para hacerlo.



Beca Excelsior

La Beca Excelsior, en combinación con otros programas de ayuda financiera para estudiantes, permite asistir a una universidad de SUNY o CUNY sin costo de matrícula, recibiendo hasta 5.500 dólares para el año académico.

Elegibilidad:

- Haberse graduado de la escuela secundaria en los Estados Unidos y obtenido un diploma de equivalencia de escuela secundaria;
- Tener un ingreso federal ajustado combinado de \$125,000 o menos;
- Enrolarse o seguir estudios universitarios en una universidad de SUNY o CUNY;
- Inscribirse en al menos 12 créditos por semestre y completar al menos 30 créditos cada año.
- Estar en camino de graduarse a tiempo con un título de asociado en dos años o un Bachillerato en cuatro años.

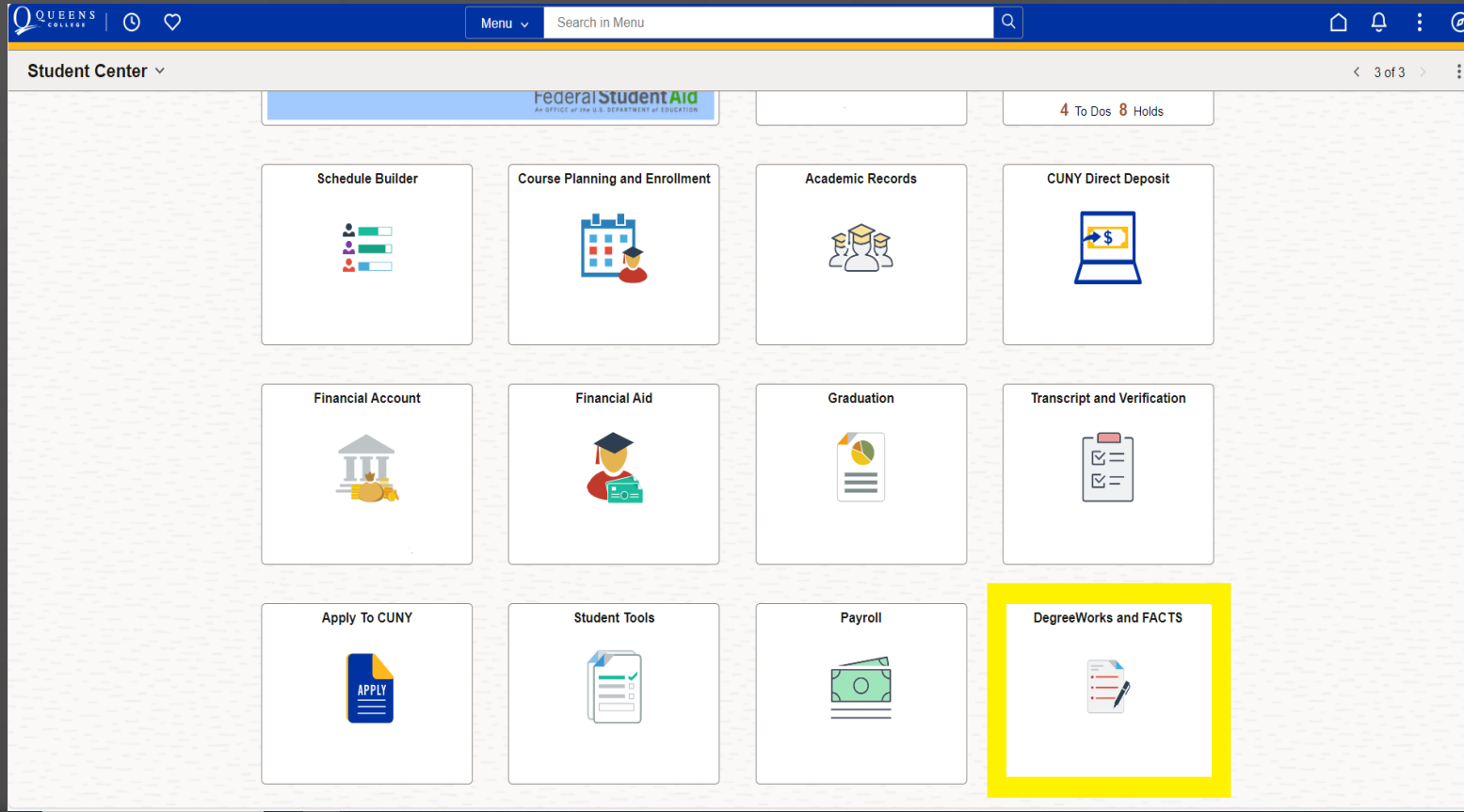

Mitos Sobre La Ayuda Financiera

- **¿Puedo solicitar ayuda financiera si tengo un título universitario de otro país?**

-Sí, un estudiante puede ser considerado con TAP/APTS/TAP a tiempo parcial si está buscando estudiar una segunda carrera de bachillerato y no ha agotado todos sus recursos disponibles de la ayuda financiera.

- **¿Puedo recibir ayuda financiera si no tengo un SSN?**

-Sí, a partir del otoño de 2019, cualquier persona que califique para la matrícula estatal, incluidos estudiantes inmigrantes e indocumentados, califican para la ayuda financiera del Estado de Nueva York, incluyendo el Programa de Asistencia para la matrícula (TAP) siempre y cuando los estudiantes cumplan con los requisitos de ingresos y otros requisitos mencionados.

- Completa todas las preguntas con precisión
- **La ayuda de TAP se solicita cada año**
- Revisa las fechas para aplicar a cada ayuda.
- Guarda copias de todos tus documentos como tu registro personal.
- La aplicación TAP estará disponible este año en diciembre
- Revise el correo electrónico mencionado en tus solicitudes de beca. Los representantes de cada ayuda se comunican primero con estudiantes antes que las universidades.
