The ASK (Alumni Sharing Knowledge) program is designed to connect Queens College alumni with current students. The program provides an opportunity for students to benefit from the broad range of knowledge in many fields of endeavor possessed by the Queens College alumni community and to practice their networking skills. In-person and virtual conversations (via Zoom), are planned for the Fall 2023, Spring and Summer 2024 semesters.

Conversations can be about life experiences, lessons alumni learned as students, or career/industry knowledge they wish to share with current students as they make decisions concerning their own careers after graduation.

Alumni can participate by being a:

- **Motivator:** expressing belief and confidence in the students' abilities and encouraging them to try new things.
- **Resource:** advising students how to make professional contacts and introducing them to new people, places, or ideas.
- **Supporter:** encouraging open and honest dialogue and listening to and responding to inquiries.
- **Mentor/Coach:** helping students work to achieve realistic and meaningful goals.
